- Thursday, April 18, from 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m at [Lynch Elementary School](#) (for all Redmond schools)

Parents are encouraged to bring the following documents to register their child for kindergarten:

- Birth certificate (child must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2013)
- Immunization records
- Proof of address (piece of mail with parents name and current address)

Representatives from various departments and services will be available for more information, including Family Advocate Network (FAN), nutrition services, student services, school health, transportation services, Redmond Area Parks and Recreation District and Boys and Girls Club of Central Oregon.
