PRESENTATION

English Language Learners 2016-17 Annual Report - Brittany Coccio

Redmond School District experienced an increase in the number of EL students from 2015-16 to 2016-17, as did the State of Oregon. The number of RSD EL students who were economically disadvantaged decreased from the previous year, however we are still slightly above the State of Oregon. RSD EL students who were homeless has increased, but the percentage of EL migrant students has decreased, however we remain one of the highest in the region. The RSD growth percentiles based on ELPA 21 shows students perform very close to the 50% mark. RSD continues to work on closing the achievement gap, to do that we offer support which includes: ELD Instruction, Dual Language Immersion Program, Community Liaisons, Migrant Services, and Interpreter/Translation Services.

ACTION ITEMS

Superintendent McIntosh presented the Consent Agenda. Included in the Consent Agenda was the required annual report to the Oregon Department of Education on our district's compliance with the Division 22 Standards. McIntosh reported there are 53 different standards that RSD is required to report on and after thorough review, he is happy to report we are in compliance with all but one of the standards. Our district chose not to go through an adoption for Social Studies in 2011 (the last adoption cycle) due to significant budget cuts and a concentrated priority to update ELA and Math curriculum. We are currently in the process of finalizing Science and PE/Health materials for adoption. We

have updated our materials for Social Studies at the secondary level and will do a full update in the next cycle in 2019, for an implementation in 2020.

Director Bennett made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Vice Chair Hartfield seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4-0.




