Policy Updates

This is the first reading of policy updates that were thoroughly reviewed by the Policy Committee, which includes Vice Chair Hartfield and Director Goodrich. No changes were made to the policies as presented. Second reading will be October 28, 2020.

Superintendent Goal Review

- Develop a way to track students logging in, their attendance, and engagement
 - Chris Morton and Mike Nye presented *Student Engagement During Comprehensive Distance Learning*
 - Analytical Tools in place include Schoolzilla (District & Building Level) as well as Canvas Learning Management System (Teacher level)
 - These tools track attendance district wide, school wide, grade level, or demographic
 - Individual students are tracked by log ins, pages viewed, duration, and assignments completed
- Put into place an Equity Task Force
 - Created an ETF goals and strategy plan
 - Received 67 applicants, reduced down to 16 members with diverse backgrounds
 - First ETF meeting was held October 8, 2020
 - Hiring Erika McCalpine, OSU Cascades as our technical advisor, next ETF meeting is November 16, 2020 with Erika for training
 - Collaborating with City of Redmond
- Build a positive and functional relationship with the REA and OSEA
 - Tracie Renwick does the majority of the interfacing
 - Will be attending meetings regularly to build stronger relationships
- Create a Superintendent Advisory Committee
 - Have not started this yet

Board Goal Review


- Continue Board professional development
